on Disaster Management.**

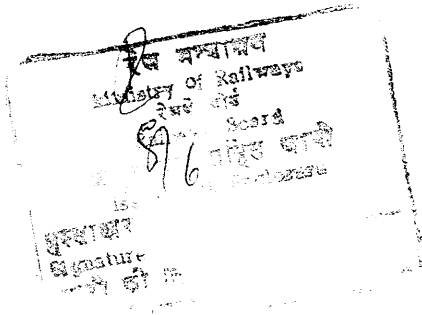
Ref. Board's letter of even number dated 29.6.2006.

Railway Board vide above referred letter has directed Indian Railways to keep few cell phones ready for making available at the site of accident for providing communication facility to the stranded passengers for talking to their family members. This facility can be provided in a convenient manner using Fixed Cellular Terminals (FCT), similar to a desktop telephone instruments, in which a SIM card can be inserted and passengers can be serviced by placing FCT on a table.

Zonal Railways are, therefore, advised to procure at least 4 FCTs for each ART to provide satisfactory service to passengers.
