**Sub: Inter Station Wireless Backup System**

A trial for Inter-station wireless backup system was conducted successfully in association with RDSO in New Delhi-Panipat section of Northern Railway by M/s GOIP Global Services, RDSO, in the trial report have recommended that this system can be used over Indian Railways for providing point-to-point backup of E1 based application in single hop section.

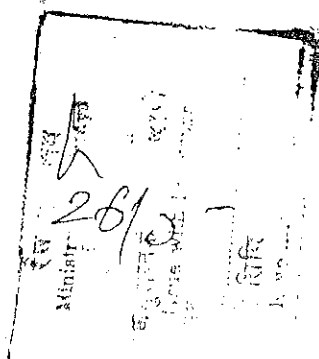
The trial report has been accepted by Board (ML). Accordingly, RDSO was advised to draw suitable specifications for inter-station wireless backup system and develop vendors for this system so that it can be used on Indian Railways.
