
The official email systems on IR (railnet.gov.in domain) are working in various divisions and zones. It has been decided that IR should have centralized email system and a work for the same has been sanctioned. This work will create a state of art email infrastructure for IR and is being done by IRPMU under North Central Railway.


2. In the interim period, it has been decided that all the Railways shall use the Railway Board's email system for hosting their emails. Railways, CTIs & PUs are, therefore, advised to migrate their email users to Railway Board's servers.

3. Every Railway/ CTIs/ PUs shall be provided with an admin user. With this admin account, the user can create and delete user accounts in their administrative control. The admin user interface can be opened only from authorized IP address. Railways may, therefore, get in touch with the undersigned along with the email domains and the IP address that will be authorized to access the email admin interface.

4. The shifting should be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2011.
