Sub: Re-positioning of satellite phones.

Ref: DOT's letter No. 800-79/2005-CS-1 dated 10.4.2012.

DOT is not issuing NOC for use of latest version of INMARSAT terminals like BGAN/Isat phones, as there is no licensed service provider for the same. In view of this, to take care of the requirement of providing urgent telephonic communication to & from the accident/derailment site, availability of CUG network needs to be mapped and in sections having complete CUG coverage, CUG phones to be used as means of providing urgent telephonic communications.

Existing Satellite phones (other than those in ARTs/ARMES) to be relocated to such sections where CUG network either does not exist or is relatively weak. All Railways are advised to undertake this exercise and arrange to re-position the Satellite Phones so as to ensure availability of communication facilities in case of accident/derailment, without any fail.
