Of late, it is seen that the applications for obtaining the Agreement-in-Principle for frequency allocation are being received from Railways in Telecom Directorate which are not complete in all respects as per requirement of WPC. This delays the whole process unnecessarily.

2. Railways are, therefore, advised that before the WPC applications are forwarded to Board, approval of CSTE on the same must be obtained and this should be clearly mentioned in the forwarding letter.
