

Board vide its letters referred to above had issued instructions for the provision of CUG phones for the Zonal Railways. It has been observed that some officers, on transfer/posting to another post, are taking their earlier allotted CUG number to their new post. This causes a lot of confusion and problems in contacting the right officer against both the posts.

The CUG numbers are post specific and it must be ensured that whenever an officer is transferred from a post to another, he hands over the CUG number to the new incumbent at the time of handing over/relinquishing the charge.
