

In continuation of Board's letters under reference, Ministry of Railways have approved provision of Closed User Group (CUG) phones to the following Workshops as detailed under:-

- a) 10 nos. of CUG phones for each of the 12 Mechanical Workshops at Tirupati, Rayanapadu, Jodhpur, Dibrugarh, New Bongaigaon, Raipur, Amritsar, Jamalpur, Mysore, Hubli, Kota and Izatnagar.
 - b) 3 nos. of CUG phones for each of the 9 Mechanical Workshops at Kurduwadi, Kalka, Tindharia, Lumding, Nagpur, Junagarh, Bhavnagar, Samastipur and Pratapnagar.
2. At locations not having mobile phone services, the CUG phones should be provided as and when the facility/service is made available.
 3. All other terms and conditions will remain the same.
 4. Necessary action may please be taken accordingly under advice to this office.


