Sub: Regarding Broadband Connection in Office to Officers in JAG or above where Railnet connectivity is not available.

As per the letters under reference above, officers in JAG or above are allowed broadband connection in their offices where Railnet has not been provided. Total financial limit of ₹3000/- per annum as usage charges was allowed for this connectivity.

2. The same has now been reviewed in Board and officers in JAG and above may be allowed to subscribe to the lowest (bandwidth) – unlimited download plan of MTNL/ BSNL in their offices where Railnet has not yet been provided. Both wired & wireless connectivity are allowed.
3. This facility may be withdrawn in case Railnet is commissioned in such office.
4. Registration/Activation charges, security deposit, CPE (Modem) monthly charges, installation/testing charges etc. as applicable for commissioning the connectivity from MTNL/BSNL is also allowed.
5. The letters referred to above stands withdrawn after issued of this policy letter.

In continuation of the letter under reference, the following installation charges for Broadband connection in the office are permitted for Internet through Broadband (BB) in addition to Rs. 3000/- per annum as usage charges:-

1.	Registration fee	Rs. 100
2.	Modem	On rental of Rs. 150/- p.m. rather than paying of Rs. 1800 on block. Broadband connection through outside operator may be discontinued as and when Railnet connectivity is given
3.	Security Deposit	Rs. 500/- (refundable)
4.	Installation	Rs. 250/-
	Total	Rs. 250/- p.m. + Rs. 500 refundable + Rs. 250/- one time installation.

The other terms and conditions of this delegation will remain the same as directed earlier.
