**Sub:- Provision of Voice Recorders in Control Offices.**

Ministry of Railways have approved provision of Voice Recorders in all Control Offices of Indian Railways. The work should be prioritized so as to provide the Voice Recorders first on major Divisions on each of the Railways and later on, on the balance Divisions progressively so as to complete the work within a period of 2-3 years i.e. by 2006-07.

2. An action plan should be drawn up so as to complete the work within 2-3 years as detailed above. The progress made on the same, may also be indicated in the Monthly Telecom Action Plan being submitted to Board. While processing proposals for provision of Voice recorders, RDSO's specifications with latest amendment(s) be adopted.
3. This issues with concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
