**Sub: Provision of Mobile Phones – under WLL scheme of
MTNL/BSNL.**

In continuation of this office letters referred to above and as per directives issued by Ministry of Finance vide their O.M. No.F.7(3)-E(Coord)/2003 dated 14.01.2004 , Ministry of Railways have approved provision of Mobile phone under WLL phones scheme of MTNL/BSNL for all officers of the rank of Joint Secretary and above for their personal use in addition to the landline connection. The facility will however be subject to the following conditions: -

- i) Monthly expenditure on the telephone call charges shall not exceed Rs.500/-.
- ii) Mobile phones under WLL shall be taken on rent from MTNL/BSNL who are giving such phones on rent as part of their on-going schemes.
- iii) All the expenditure on this account shall be met within the existing budget for “Office Expenses-Telephones” of the concerned Ministry/Department/Organization and no additional funds shall be provided for the expenditure head “Telephones”;
- iv) The officer allotted the mobile phone connection would be responsible for proper maintenance of the hand set which will remain Government property. The concerned officer will have to make good any damage/loss to the hand set which will need to be surrendered at the time of handing over of the charge.

2. Officers would be provided with only one facility – In other words, officers already provided with CUG/Cellular phones would not be provided with WLL phones and vice-versa. If an officer is eligible for both the facilities, i.e., Cellular/CUG phones and WLL phones by virtue of post/rank or any other directives, it should be ensured that only one facility viz; CUG or Cellular or WLL phone, is retained/provided to the officers.

3. Necessary action may be taken accordingly and compliance reported to this office.


