Sub:- Provision of Wireless in Local Loop (WLL) Exchange having 50 -line capacity.

Ref: The High level Committee's report on 'Disaster Management' Over Indian Railways – Recommendation No.'97'

Ministry of Railways have decided that one WLL Exchange having 50-line capacity be provided in all the ARTs at Divisional Headquarters of Indian Railways. In phase-I, the WLL exchange may be provided in one ART of one Divisional Headquarter on your Railway and a performance report of the same submitted to Board's Office by 31.03.2004.

2. - Decision to extend this facility on balance ARTs, in Phase-II, would be taken on the basis of feedback received from the Railway.
3. Expenditure for provision of the WLL exchange in Phase-I as detailed in para -1 above may be charged to Revenue Grant of the Railway.
4. Detailed instructions/guidelines for implementation of the decision are being issued separately.
5. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
