Approval of the Ministry of Railways is hereby communicated for payment of the proportionate fibre maintenance charges payable by Railways to RailTel at the rate of ₹ 115.15 (Rupees One hundred fifteen and paise fifteen only) for the year 2013-14 and ₹ 124.43 (Rupees one hundred twenty four and paise fourty three only) for the year 2014-15 plus Service Tax per Km per month per pair of fibre. Telecom Circulars no. 13/2012 and 01/2014 outlining the procedure for payment of maintenance charges may be followed.




