
Sub: Allowing 3G/4G data on CUG connections to all CUG users

Ref: Railway Board's Telecom Circulars No. RB Tele 04/2006 & 11/2015

In Continuation of Board's letters under reference, Railway Board has approved the following:-

- i. All CUG users are allowed to subscribe to 3G/4G services on their CUG connections.
  - ii. 3G/4G services should be provided as per their choice within the existing CUG limits as prescribed in Board's letter no: 2004/Tele/TN/3 dt. 07.06.2006. There will be no additional financial implication on Indian Railways due to introduction of 3G/4G service and it should be activated on demand basis only. The excess charges should be automatically deducted from their salary.
