

This has reference to RailTel's above referred letter regarding service support for local LAN and Railway Vigilance VPN Network and related annual recurring charges.

2. The matter has been examined in this office and following decisions have been taken :

- a) Recurring charges for VPN Ports, AMC of Hardware and Internet Bandwidth charges will be met by Zonal Railways on the same lines as is being done in case of Railnet network. However, AMC charges should be based on the actual expenditure on the AMC and not a fixed percentage of the cost of equipments installed.
 - b) Annual charges for Managed Services under which RailTel will be responsible to provide support upto LAN level etc. will be met by Vigilance Directorate of Railway Board
3. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
