Sub: Banning of business dealings with M/s R.L. Roy Constructions, Malda.

M/s R.L. Roy Constructions, Malda was awarded the works contract for repairing of Over Head alignment, laying of cable, release of ACSR and GI wire and drawing of telecom cable etc. at various locations at Malda.

A joint surprise check was conducted on 26.3.2002 by the joint team of Officers from CBI/ACB/Kolkata and Vigilance wing of Kolkata. It was found that the cables were laid in the trenches, depth of which were not as per specifications (1 mtr, deep). Digging at 7 places was done but at no place the trench was found to be 1 mtr. deep. This has not only resulted in substandard execution of work but also loss to the railways in terms of excess payment as the firm had drawn full amount of money against the relevant item without executing the work as per schedule.


The memorandum of imputations was served on M/s R.L. Roy Constructions, Malda through Eastern Railway and the firm represented against the charges mentioned therein.

The competent authority has carefully considered the entire matter including the representation received from the firm and has come to the conclusion that the firm had drawn full amount of money against the relevant item without executing the work as per schedule.

In view of the position stated in the preceding paras, it has been finally decided by the Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) after a careful consideration of the entire matter that the business dealings with M/s R.L.Roy Constructions, Malda whose address is given below and their allied concerns are banned on All Indian Railways including all Production units etc. under the Ministry of Railways on permanent basic with immediate effect.

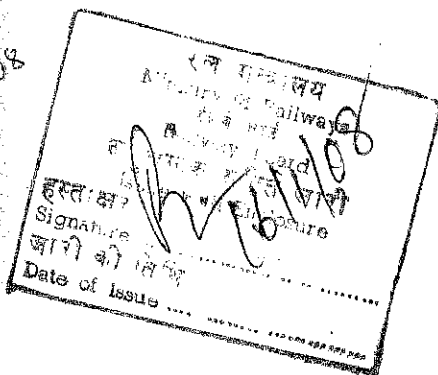
